Causes for a Discrepancy

EFC

Income (AGI)

Taxes Paid



• What won't cause a 399 C Code?

- Number in household
- Number in college
- Assets



SAR C Code

- SAR C Code requires further verification by the financial aid administrator (FAA).
- The FAA may contact the FAFSA applicant to resolve issues related to differences in the 2015 income information reported on the 2016/2017 and 2017/2018 FAFSAs.



What's required to resolve the 399 code?

- Use of DRT on either 16-17 or 17-18 FAFSA
- 1040s
- W2s
- 1098T
- Documentation on other untaxed benefits



CPS Modifications

 Students with an automatic-zero EFC for the 2017/2018, CPS will now compare financial information provided for the 2017/2018 to the student's 2016/2017 financial information; SAR Comment Code 399 will only be assigned if the EFC difference calculated by the CPS is over a certain threshold.



CPS Modifications

- 2016-2017 Professional Judgement
 - Excluded if it was processed as a PJ



CPS Reprocessing

• CPS conducted a reprocessing on February 6, 2017 for the 2017/2018 student records with an auto-zero EFC on their 2017/2018 records or a professional judgment on their 2016/2017 record. SAR Comment Code 399 may be added or removed (as needed).



CPS Reprocessing

 CPS reprocessing will potentially add or remove comment code 399 from the records identified as being affected by this issue.

 Dependent students with student financial information, and qualified for the cross-year EFC calculation and edit.



- CPS Reprocessing
- Reprocessed Institutional Student Information Records (ISIRs) were sent under the IGSG180P message class.
- SARs and ISIRs will include SAR comment code "172". "SAR was produced because we processed a change to your financial based on information reported to us by another agency or as a result of a processing system change.

• Student is selected for verification after clearing C code. Do you have to complete verification?



The SAR FAA information page in Student Inquiry on the FAA Access to CPS Online Web site will display "02" – reprocessed because Comment Code 399 not assigned correctly" for the Reprocessing Code for the transaction resulting from the reprocessing.
