



What is Personal Brand?

The conscious and *intentional* effort to create and influence public perception of an individual by positioning them as an *authority* in their industry, elevating their credibility, and differentiating themselves from the competition, to ultimately *advance their career*, *increase their circle of influence*, and have a *larger impact*.

Personal brand tip 2: Build a board of directors



Board of Directors: help protect the value of a company for shareholders

Select board members who are invested in you and want to see you win.

Personal brand tip 3: Practice self development



Self development

- Create a personal development plan (write it down)

Personal brand tip 4: Find a mentor

- Find a mentor (doesn't have to be within your field)
- Set expectations
- Be prepared
- Drive the relationship
- Respect the relationship


Personal branding tip 8: Tell your story

- ✓ Your personal brand precedes you. What is it saying?
- ✓ How do you stay top of mind for decision makers?
- ✓ How do you share your good news?
- ✓ Are you sharing your expertise?
- ✓ What does a Google search reveal about you?

- ✓ Keywords
- ✓ Personalized URL
- Create an interesting headline
- ✓ Create blogs
- ✓ Add multimedia
- Include note with connections

- Add board leadership and volunteer experiences
