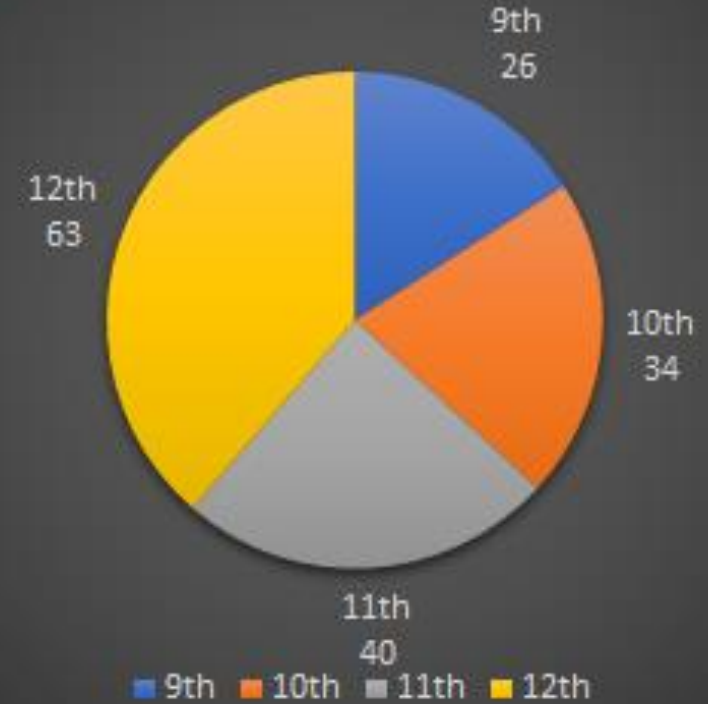

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Undergraduate PAC Pathway

- Direct pathway to University of Pittsburgh
 - Meet PAC participation requirements
 - Commit to Pathway Spring semester senior year
 - Enroll at CCAC for 1-2 years
 - Guaranteed admission to Pitt
 - Access to FPP benefits
- PAC Pathway requirements
 - 80% PAC Session attendance
 - Maintain a 2.75 GPA or above
 - Annually complete FAFSA
 - Attend PAC meetings and events
 - Maintain communication with coordinator and mentor

Future Pitt Panther Benefits

- Guaranteed admission to the University of Pittsburgh campus of their choice
- Continuous support from high school until degree attainment

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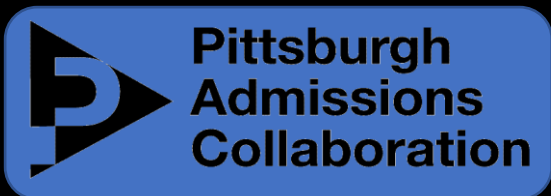
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
