Uses of FAFSA Data



- Compute the expected family contribution (EFC) as a measure of the student's and family's ability to pay for college
- Confirm student eligibility criteria using various database matches with federal agencies
- Determine estimated aid eligibility

Uses of FAFSA Data




- Supplemental forms or applications
 - Eligibility for state or institutional aid
 - Permitted for federal aid only to:
 - > Verify FAFSA information
 - > Resolve conflicting information

- Allows for real time, online submission of initial/renewal FAFSA and any corrections
- Offers instructions and help text
- Uses skip-logic and edits

This Web site is a demonstration version of Federal Student Adrs 2021-2022 and 2020-2021 FAFSA on the Web and FAEA Access to CPS Clinice sites. The site provides a way for francois and administrators to show students and parents, as well as financial and office sites from the Web and FAEA Access to CPS Clinice.  Printed signature pages include a "test sample" watermark and should not be mailed to the processor. The demo signature page will not be accepted or processed.

 If another user saves a remember or correction application in FAFSA on the Web, other users will not know the save key and
- have to start a new transaction.

 Unlike the production list, the "CPS Web Applications Demo System" page is considered the FAFSA "Home" page. When a user selects "Exit" or "Home" from the Demo site, they will be directed to the "CPS Web Applications Demo System" page.

Pre-leaded fest data is provided for applications that depend on historical data such as renewal applications, corrections, print SAR, application status chick; student injury, and electronic spratures. Multiple transactions exist for fest cases where the highest transaction number is greater than 91. FAA login information is also provided for FAA Access to CPS Online applications on the Den site.

Database	Items Checked During Match
a. Social Security Administration	Suspension or termination of eligibility for federal benefits due to drug offense conviction
b. Department of Homeland Security	Registration with Selective Service (if required)
c. Selective Service System	Valid SSN, Master Death File, and U.S. citizenship
d. National Student Loan Data System	Veteran status
e. Department of Defense	Eligible noncitizen status
f. Department of Veterans Affairs	Default on Title IV loans, excess borrowing, repayment of fraudulently obtained Title IV funds, outstanding overpayments of Title IV grants and loans, and unusual enrollment history
g. Department of Justice Hold File	Death of a parent or guardian as a result of military service in Iraq or Afghanistan after 9/11/01





 - Update = correct data
 - Correction = incorrect data

FAFSA Changes: Adjustments




- Financial aid administrator may exercise professional judgment (PJ) authority
