




The Problem


Too many systematically marginalized students are being left behind, leading to growing racial inequality, larger wealth gaps, and less opportunity.

Meanwhile, each year, millions of youth graduate from high school with a diploma from an antiquated education system unequipped with the skills, mindset, and network they need to succeed in the 21st-century workforce.

Nearly 1/2 of employers indicate **soft skills** make up the greatest skills gap



7 in 10 current high schoolers report **feeling bored** in school





Referrals and networking account for 60% of job hires.
