The 1983-84 Pell Payment Schedule is attached. This information has been provided to us from the Education Department, Regional Office in Philadelphia and can be considered the official Pell Payment Schedule for the coming academic year.

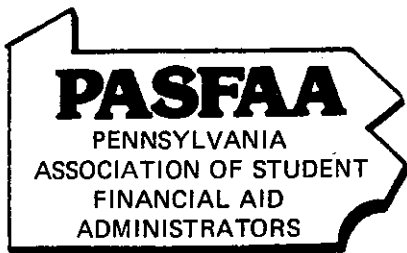
A complete *Dear Colleague* letter and information regarding the payment schedule will shortly be released by the Education Department. In addition, NASFAA reports that it will include the Pell Payment Schedule in Federal Monitor No. 80 to be mailed shortly. The May 2 NASFAA Newsletter reports that the 1983-84 schedule is very similar to that used in 1979-80. The maximum award is \$1,800, and there are no linear or rateable reductions to awards for eligibility indices greater than zero. The difference between the 1979-80 and 1983-84 schedules is due to different rounding (typically of one dollar) in about one half of all the award cells, NASFAA points out.

PASFAA is pleased to provide this timely and important information to its members through this Special Edition of the Newsletter.
