#### **NLA Summer High School U**

The Summer High School U Program is a FREE eight week program for rising 10th -12th grade low-income students living in the City of Pittsburgh and surrounding suburbs in Allegheny County (There are limited spots for non-low-income students interested in health, social services, teaching/counseling, and business careers to participate).







## Program Perks

- High school students earn 3 or 4 college credits in summer
- Learn & Earn eligible students are paid for 25 hours/week, to be in class, receive tutoring, and have a summer internship. (limited spaces for non eligible Learn & Earn students)
- Free bus pass
- The program pay for all necessary materials for the class (ex: books, calculator, etc).


